Course Description: This <u>40-hour course</u> consists of eleven units of instruction and is intended to expand on the skills and tools previously presented during the 80-hour Basic Intelligence Analyst Course.

This course will present more advanced analytical and investigative tools and the analyst's role in support of complex conspiracy investigations. Course blocks include investigative, analytical, and strategic writing; intelligence collection and analysis through source debriefings; financial analysis; crypto-currency investigations; open source and conspiracy investigations. Students will have the opportunity to practice acquired skills in practical and hands-on classroom exercises.

Who Should Attend: Intelligence and Criminal Analysts

Education Hours: This course may qualify for training credit from your agency.

Dress Code: Uniform or Business Casual (**NO** Shorts/Flip-Flops)

Lodging: Students are responsible for their own hotel and per diem costs. Hotel information will be included with the confirmation email.
