This course is intended to provide officers with information and practical skills needed to conduct drug investigations in today's ever-changing environment. Students will be exposed to the latest methods and investigative techniques.

**Who Should Attend:** Narcotic Officers, Detectives, Drug Unit Supervisors, and General Investigators.
