

STREET DEVELOPMENT

Prerequisites:

Students must be full-time, commissioned peace officers working for a law enforcement agency.

Course Description:

The Street Development class takes law enforcement officers through the many facets of narcotics, from cultivation or manufacturing, transportation and distribution, paraphernalia associated with the packaging, sales, and use, to signs and symptoms of influence. Students will learn to recognize aspects of narcotics enabling them to articulate reasonable suspicion. They will understand how to develop probable cause arrests and write proper reports. Participants will have an opportunity to have "hands-on" experience, manipulating paraphernalia, preparing methods of ingestions for multiple drugs, and examining authentic items of narcotic users and sellers. Topics to be discussed include marijuana in its various forms, opiates (heroin, fentanyl, pharmaceuticals), methamphetamine, cocaine, ecstasy, synthetic substances, and other substances of abuse. Officers will leave the class feeling empowered to recognize, articulate and confident to make lawful arrests, they may have missed, making their communities safer!
