Prerequisites:

Students must be full-time, commissioned peace officers, criminal analysts working for a law enforcement agency.

Course Description:

This presentation will debrief the shooting incident that occurred on the Amtrak train during an interdiction operation on October 4, 2021, in Tucson, Arizona. Given by the interdiction team's sergeant, and the Tucson Police patrol sergeant, both of whom were involved that day. The presentation will also take you through the post shooting investigation into the two suspects involved and discuss some of the lessons learned.
