



Primary Prevention Advanced Course (PPAC)

What is it:

The goal of PPAC is to expand on the knowledge and skills learned in SPF Application for Prevention Success Training (SAPST). This course is intended as an advanced level course to prepare substance use and misuse prevention practitioners to effectively support community-based organizations in their primary prevention efforts. They will gain practical knowledge of how to apply the phases of the Strategic Prevention Framework (SPF) model within their communities, as well as enable participants and agencies to gain the ability to enhance their efforts and design prevention programs that create real, long-term results.

This program is designed for members of the community who work with community-based organizations in the field of prevention, who wish to expand their knowledge, skills, and capabilities
